LAST CIRCULAR FOR THE ICRC

Dear Participant,

Herewith you find some useful information for your arrival in Rio and to the ICRC next week.

1. **There will be people associated to the organisation of the ICRC2013**, carrying conference banners, at the Galeão International Airport to help you. They will be there on the 1st of July, Monday, between 5:30 am and 5: 50 pm, and can be contacted in the following numbers: +55 21 9469 8980 (Rogério de Almeida) and +55 21 8623 9264 (Mary Díaz Castro).
2. There are **no transfers organised** to take you from the airport to your hotel. We recommend you take the shuttle buses or the special airport cabs which you can book from the counters to go to the city.
3. **Emergency contact phones** are available in case you need to contact someone from the LOC upon your arrival in Rio. Should you need any assistance, please call +55 21 9580 4456 (Ulisses Barres) or +55 21 8102 0752 (João Torres).
4. **Talks must be uploaded well in advance** from the time of your talk, and preferentially no later than the morning of the day before your presentation. The best way is that you have your talk uploaded to INDICO as soon as possible, but you will have the chance to do it during the conference if you need. Contact the LOC via email if you have any doubts about how to upload your talk.
5. **Posters** will be on display from the 2nd of July onwards, and all participants are requested to hang their posters early in the morning on the day of their session. Each poster will be exposed for two full days, after which a new they will be replaced by a new session, in a total of three 2-day sessions. Please, take down your posters at the end of the last day of your session. The place for your poster will be clearly marked for each session.
6. Free **wifi will be available** at the meeting venue. The network name is **icrc2013** and the password is **cosmicrays**.
7. It is **not usual to tip taxis**, and you should not do so, except for rounding up values. Taxis are metered, with an starting fare of about BRL 5.00. Night fares is a little bit higher than a day trip.
8. **Tips in restaurants are normally included in the bill**, as a 10% service charge. This extra charge is not mandatory and you can refuse paying it if you feel unhappy with the service.
